Regular school attendance can lead to better relationships with their friends, which is a protective factor for mental health and wellbeing.

Before Covid, in 2018/19, just 40% of children whose attendance was below 90% (persistently absent) at the end of Year 6 achieved expected KS2 standards, compared with 84% of children who were regular attenders
