School and PE uniform



Please could all parents/carers ensure that children are adhering to the rules and expectations of school and PE uniform. Please see below for a reminder on school and PE uniform:

Summer School uniform should be as follows:

- Tops - pale blue polo shirt with or without school logo OR pale blue short sleeved shirt with school tie
- Cardigan/sweatshirt - navy V neck sweatshirt or cardigan with or without school logo
- Trousers/shorts - grey
- Grey Skirts or pinafore dress or, blue and white gingham dress , skirts and dresses to be worn no shorter than just above the knee
- Socks/tights - ankle or knee length grey or white socks, tights should be grey or navy
- Footwear - black school shoes suitable for the school day

PE uniform should be as follows:

No other brands or logos should be worn, other than the St Mary's logo.

- PE t-shirt - white polo or t-shirt with or without the school logo
- PE jumper - St Mary's logoed hoodie or plain navy hoodie without school logo
- Shorts/PE skirt - navy blue
- Joggers - plain navy blue
- Socks - white or grey s
- Footwear - trainers or pumps

Accessories should be as follows:

- Hair - smart hair styles suitable for school, shoulder length hair tied back
- Make up - not allowed
- A small pair of stud earrings, these should be removed by your child before PE or we advise parents to either take out earrings before school
- Other jewellery - not allowed
- Scarves/headbands - plain navy or black

**Please ensure that all school uniform and PE uniform is clearly labelled with your child's full name.
